DAY 1: WINDHOEK - SOSSUSVLEI

This morning, you will travel from Windhoek through the scenic highlands of the Great Escarpment, before arriving into the Namib Desert. Two nights at DEAD VALLEY LODGE. (L, D)

DAY 2: SOSSUSVLEI

Wake early to explore the Namib Naukluft National Park, setting off before sunrise to capture a view of the dunes with the dramatic morning light on them. Explore Sossusvlei, Deadvlei and other nearby dunes, before enjoying a picnic lunch. (B, L, D)

DAY 3: SWAKOPMUND

Early this morning, you have the option to enjoy a sunrise balloon flight or scenic light aircraft flight (at additional cost) over the Namib Naukluft National Park. Afterwards, drive through desert landscapes en-route to Walvis Bay and the Namibian coast. Continue north to the seaside haven of Swakopmund and enjoy the afternoon at your leisure to explore the town before enjoying dinner at a local seafood restaurant. Two nights at THE DELIGHT HOTEL. (B. L. D)

DAY 4: SWAKOPMUND

After breakfast, you will be driven along the scenic coastal road back south to Walvis Bay for a kayaking adventure. Cape fur seals, bottlenose dolphins, flamingos and a wide variety of seabirds are just some of the wildlife commonly spotted. There is also the option to partake in a boat excursion to the outer lagoon instead. After exploring the waterfront area of Walvis Bay, return to Swakopmund for an afternoon at leisure. (B, L, D)

DAY 5: SWAKOPMUND - DAMARALAND

Today you will head towards Damaraland and en-route you will pass Namibia's highest mountain, Brandberg Mountain. Spend the day admiring the captivating landscape of this area, from its table-top mountains to its bizarre looking rock formations. If time permits, visit the pre-historic rock engravings at Twyfelfontein. Two nights at CAMP KIPWE. (B, L, D)

DAY 6: DAMARALAND

After breakfast, you will be taken on an exciting 4x4 excursion along the Aba Huab and Huab River valleys in search of the elusive desert elephants and other rare game. The afternoon is at your leisure, with the option to enjoy a guided walk in the local area. On return to camp, the rest of your day is at leisure. (B, L, D)

DAY 7: DAMARALAND - SOUTHERN ETOSHA NATIONAL PARK

After an early breakfast, journey to Ongava Game Reserve, situated on the southern border of Etosha National Park. Arrive in time for an afternoon game drive, exploring the open plains and woodlands that are home to lion, leopard, rhino, giraffe, zebra and much more. Three nights at ONGAVA COLLECTION. (B, L, D)

DAY 8: SOUTHERN ETOSHA NP

Today you will depart on an early morning game drive in Etosha National Park. Upon return to your accommodation, enjoy lunch before departing on an afternoon game drive. There is also the option for a full day game drive with picnic lunch. Spend your evening game viewing whilst enjoying dinner at the camp's waterhole. (B, L, D)

DAY 9: ETOSHA NATIONAL PARK – ONGUMA GAME RESERVE

Today, you will be taken on another memorable morning of game viewing within Etosha National Park. Return to camp for lunch, then spend the afternoon on a game drive within the private Onguma Game Reserve. After sunset, enjoy your final safari dinner overlooking the waterhole. (B, L, D)

DAY 10: ONGUMA GAME RESERVE - WINDHOEK

This morning, you will visit the AfriCat Foundation, a wildlife sanctuary which focuses on the research and rehabilitation of Africa's big cats. After lunch, enjoy an afternoon game drive and tour of the centre. You will then be transferred back to Windhoek Airport, or your accommodation (not included). (B, L)
